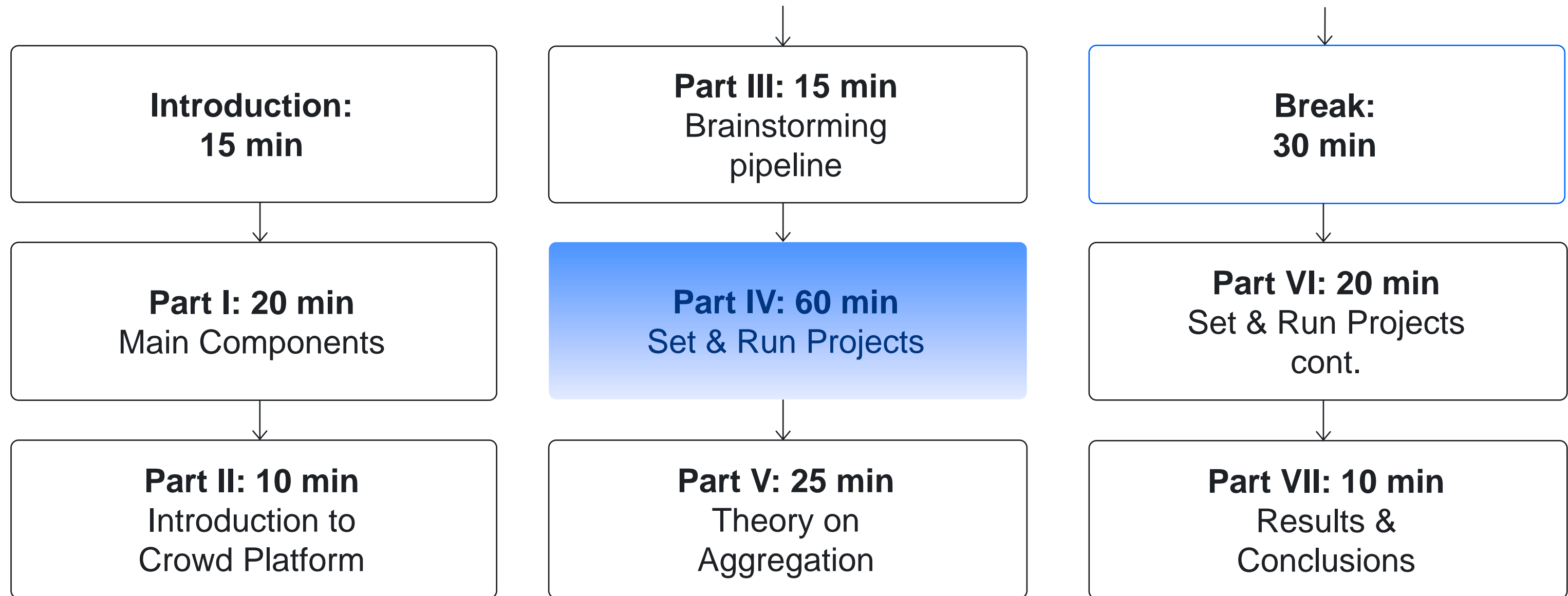

# Practice: creating a real crowdsourcing pipeline

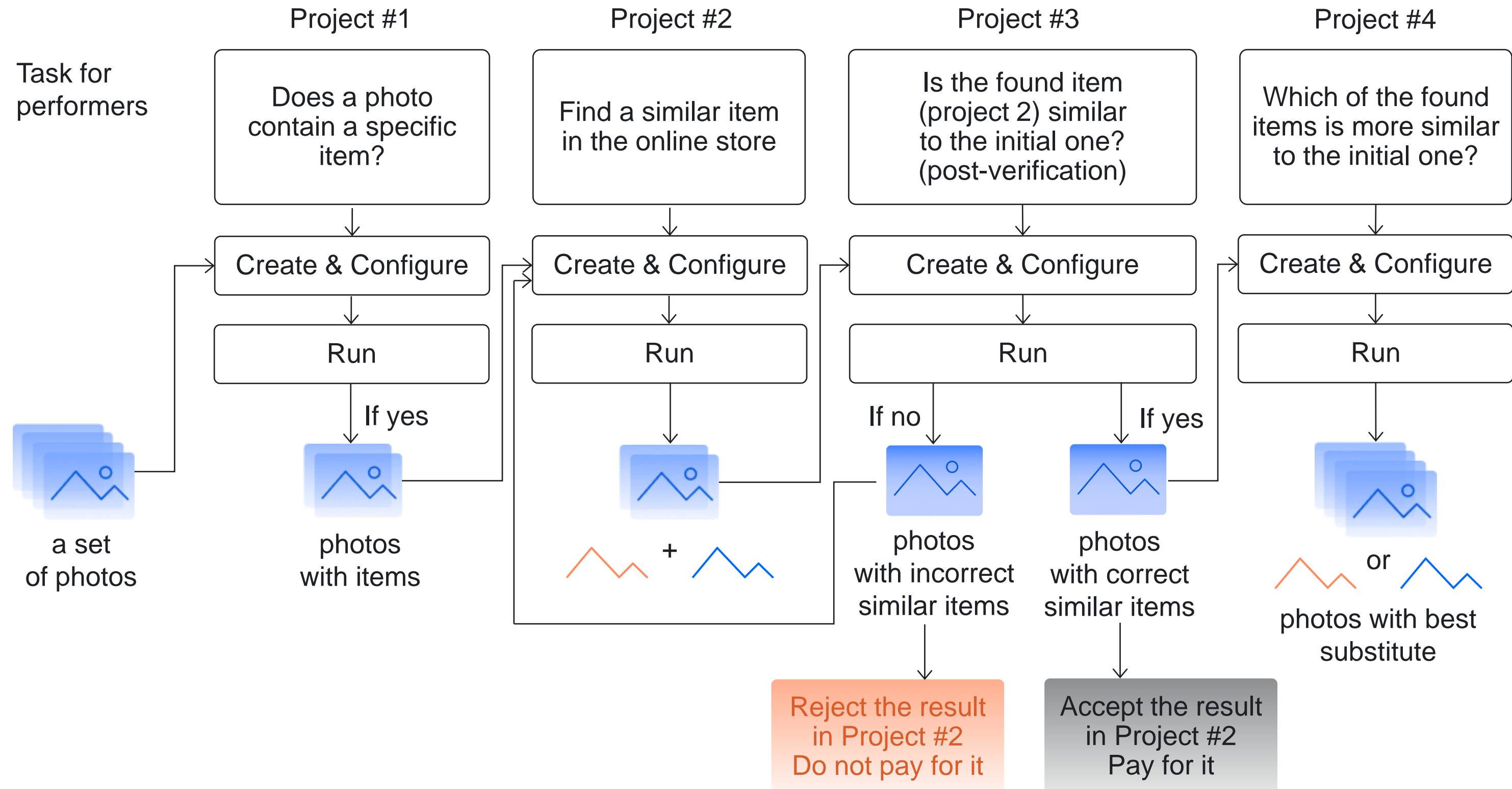
Now we will create a real simplified crowdsourcing pipeline

**To simplify the task, we ask you to:**

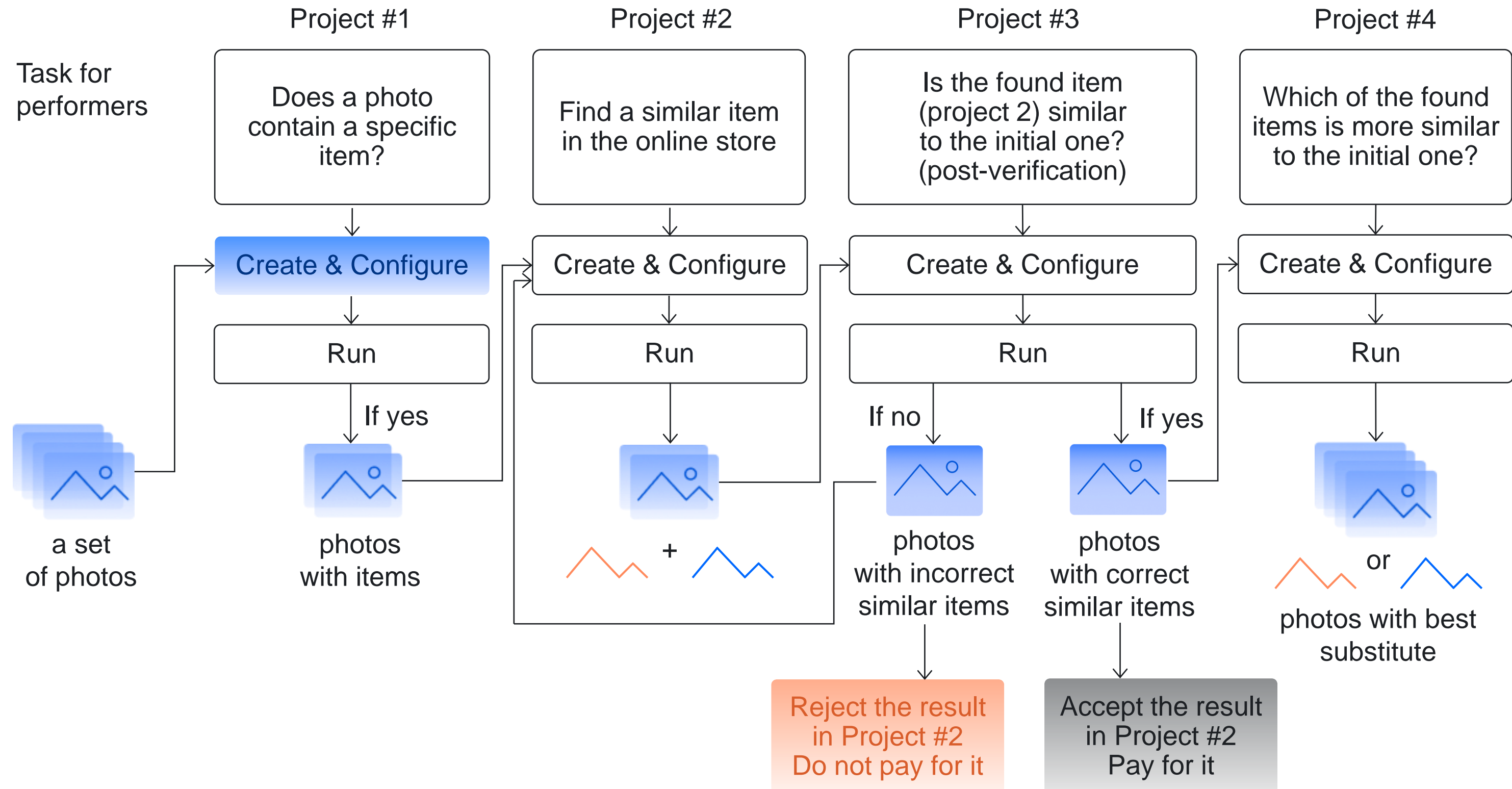
- ▶ Finding a substitute for one type of item
- ▶ Choose any item you want to find the best substitute for. For example, Shoes



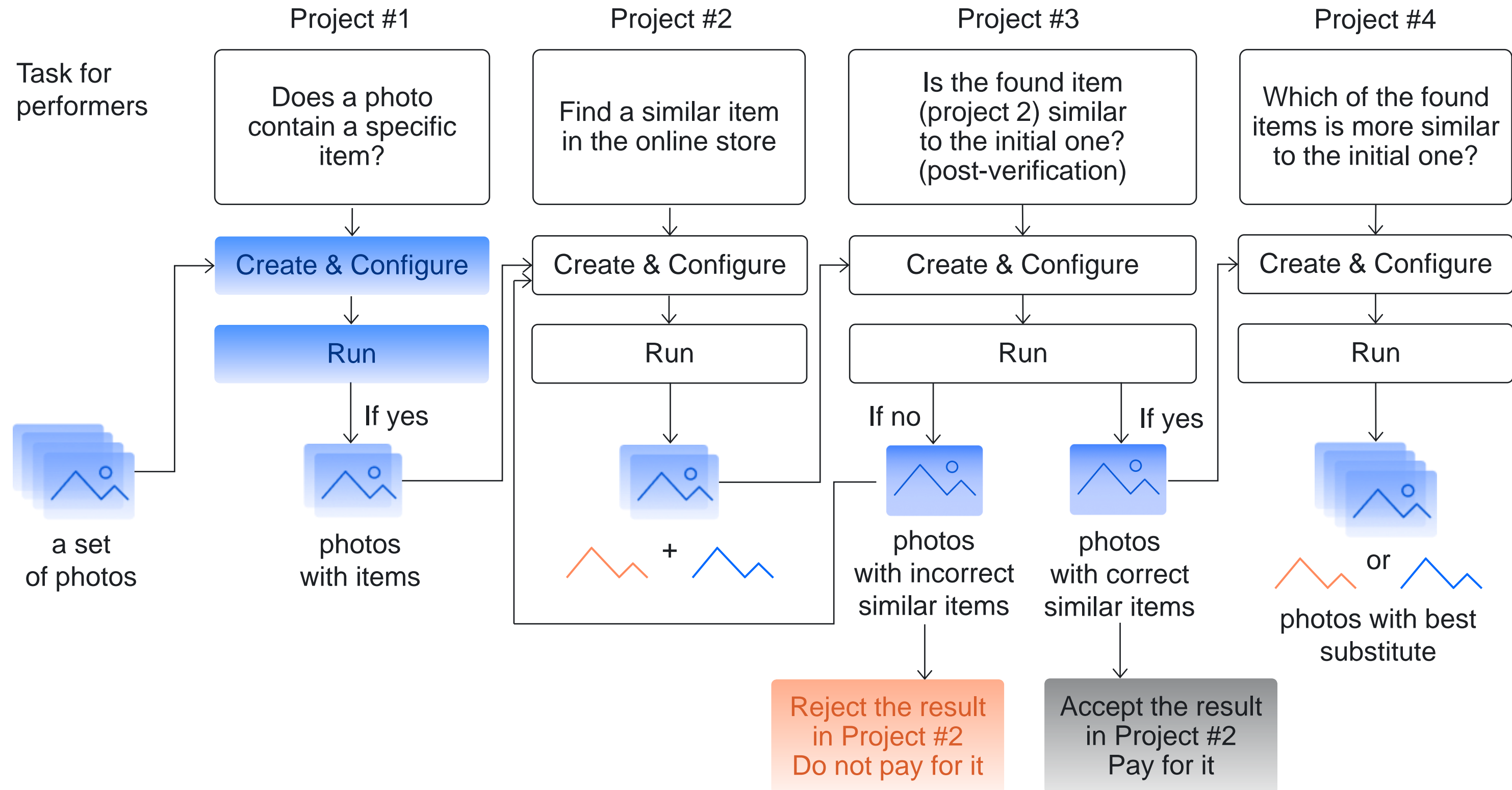
